OPEN TOP CONTAINER POLICY CHANGE

Effective September 2, 2004. The key to the open container cage will be handled by the security department. Housekeeping will notify the security department every time that they need to use the container. All residents who have paid to use the compactor will also go to security for the key. The security officer who opens the cage will log the unit #, time and his name or call sign. The other changes are as follows.

## FULL CONTAINER

\$500.00

The resident has 30 days or 8 trips, which will be monitored not to exceed the full container.

### **½ CONTAINER**

\$250.00

The resident has 4 trips in 14 days in which to load ½ the container, the trips will also be monitored so as not to exceed the ½ container.

## **¼ CONTAINER**

\$150.00

The resident has 2 trips in 7days in which to load the ¼ container, the trips will be monitored so as not to exceed the ¼ container.
